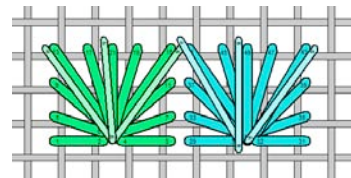

#2203; Sparkle Braid #SK06

Stitch: Ray Stitch
*Stitch the first layer with the
"flat" fibers, then come back
and repeat the three top stitches
in the white Sparkle Braid.*



Area: Coral Leg

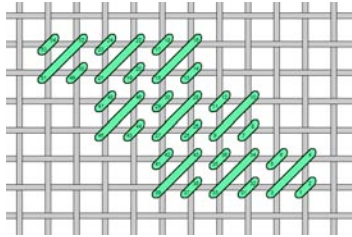
Fibers: 4Ply City Needlework
Silk #13, #40, #4 Braid #008,
1/16th" Ribbon #085

Stitch: Tent

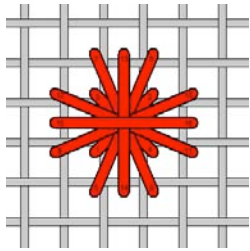

Area: White Dots on Coral
Fiber: Magnifica #10009
Technique: Apply Beads with a cross-stitch.

Fiber: Weeks Dye Works Floss #2203
Stitch: Mosaic

Fiber: Soft Sheen Fyrewerks #FT43
Stitch: Rhodes



Area: Blue Ground
Fiber: Hyla's High Cotton #433
Stitch: Tent

Area: Flamingoes
Fibers: City Needlework Silk #13, #40; #8 Braid #192, #12 Braid #191; Vineyard Silk #C-111
Stitch: Tent

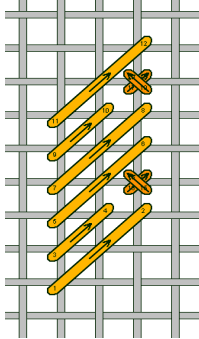
Area: Wreaths
Fibers: Magnifica #10040, #10107; Seed Bead #62032

Technique: Basketweave Beading

- The first step is to come up in the lower left hand hole, go through the bead, then back down in the upper right hand hole. The bead will slant

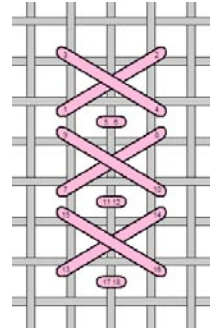
- from the lower left to the upper right, just like the stitch.
- When covering a horizontal thread, come back up in the upper left hand hole, go through the bottom of the bead (the end nearest the lower left hand hole), and then go back down in the lower right hand hole. This will "pull" the bead into a horizontal position.
- Moving just like basketweave, continue to apply any beads covering horizontal threads in that diagonal row.
- When covering a vertical thread, follow the first step. For the second step, come up in the lower right hand hole, go through the bottom of the bead and then go back down in the upper left hand hole. This will "pull" the bead into a vertical position.
- Moving just like basketweave, continue to apply beads covering vertical threads in that diagonal row.

Area: Wide Lime Stripe
Fibers: Petite Sparkle Rays #PS02
Stitch: Cashmere with Beads

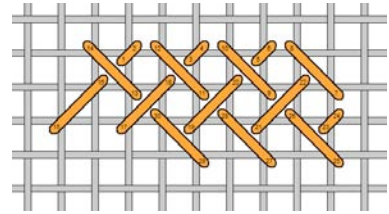


Area: Narrow Pink, Blue, and Sand Stripes; Wide Dark Green Stripe
Fibers: City Needlework Silk #13; Soft Sheen Fyrewerks #FT43; Sprinkles #54; 1/16th" Ribbon #085
Stitch: Tent

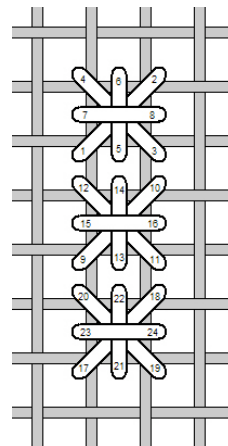
Area: Wide Pink Stripe
Fiber: City Needlework Silk #13
Stitch: Elongated Cross with Fill



Area: Wide Sand Stripe
Fiber: Sprinkles #54
Stitch: Woven



Area: White Stripe
Fiber: #12 Braid #191
Stitch: Smyrna Cross



Area: Green Stripe
Fiber: Magnifica #10107
Technique: Apply beads with a cross-stitch so that the holes line up vertically.
