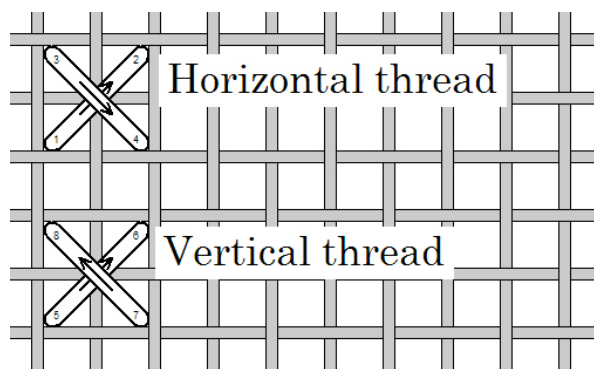
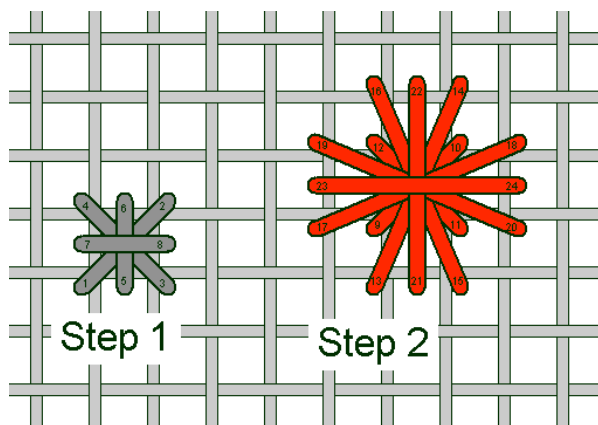

Area: Background
Fiber: #8 Braid #9032
Stitch: Woven

Area: Green Dots
Fibers: Petite Very Velvet #V602, Soft Sheen Fyre Werks #FT22
Stitch: Padded Rhodes
 Apply a Smyrna cross in the center of each dot with Very Velvet; apply the Rhodes on top with the Fyre Werks.



Area: Crabs
Fibers: Magnifica #10035, #10049, #10065, #10086, 11/0 Delica #DB1764
Technique: Basketweave Beading
 Recommended beading threads: clear Sulky sewing thread; 4lb Test Fireline

- Beads are applied with cross-stitches, moving in diagonal rows, like basketweave.
- The first stitch of the cross-stitch, no matter which directional thread you are covering, goes from the lower left, through the bead, then back down in the upper right.
- When covering a vertical thread, the second stitch will come up in the lower right, come back through the bead from the bottom (lower left end) and then go back down in the upper left.
- When covering a horizontal thread, the second stitch will come up in the upper left, come back through the bead from the bottom (lower left end) and then go back down in the lower right.
- Move between stitches in diagonal rows, just like basketweave.

Graphs are for representation of the rhythm of a stitch, and may not fit the specific, painted area. Unless otherwise instructed, the stitches should be compensated to fit the painted area, appropriately.
