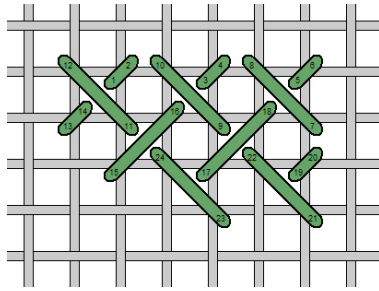

Fiber: Hyla's High Cotton #432
Stitch: Tent

Area: White Stripe
Fiber: #8 Braid #032
Stitch: Woven



Area: Gold Dot
Fiber: Magnifica #10091
Technique: Apply bead with a cross-stitch.

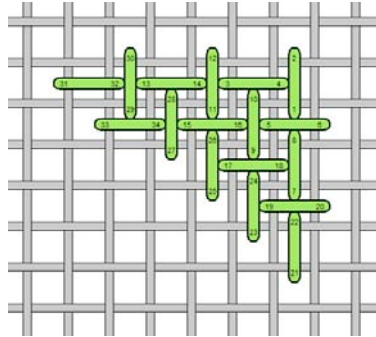
Area: Cream Stripe
Fiber: 11/0 Delica #DB0382, #DB1581
Technique: Line Beading

- Apply beads with a cross-stitch so that the interior holes line up vertically.
- Once entire line is complete, come back up in the lower left hole, run the needle through all of the beads, then go back down in the upper right hole.
- Come back up in the upper left hole, run through the beads, then go back down in the lower right hole.

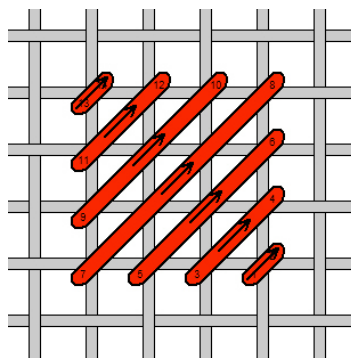
Area: Crab
Fibers: Vineyard Silk #C-007, #C-183, #C-213
Stitch: Tent

Area: Crab Eyes
Fiber: Hot Fix Crystal, #SS12 Jet
Technique: Apply crystals with an appropriate Hot Fix tool. If Hot Fix is either not available, or not desired, substitute Smyrna Crosses using #12 Kreinik Braid #005.

Area: Green Background
Fiber: #4 Braid #015
Stitch: Reverse Basketweave



Area: White Ground of Plaid
Fiber: 1/16th" Ribbon, #100
Stitch: Scotch Stitch

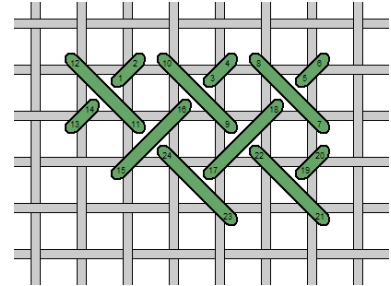


Area: Plaid
Fibers: 11/0 Delica #DB1304, #DB1308, #DB1246; Magnifica #10065, #10106, #10113
Technique: Line Beading
Work in horizontal and vertical sections, using the long cross-stitch of anchoring each section.

Area: Starfish
Fibers: Vineyard Silk #C-044, #C-137, #C-190
Stitch: Tent

Area: White Dots on Starfish
Fiber: #8 Braid #032
Stitch: Cross-Stitch

Area: Pink Ground
Fiber: Petite Silk Lame #SP45
Stitch: Woven



Area: Lime Ground
Fibers: Splendor #S972, #S1105
Stitch: Tent

Area: Swirls
Fibers: 11/0 Delica #DB1308, Magnifica #10113
Technique: Curved Line Beading

- Apply beads with a cross-stitch so the hole of the bead lines up with the direction of the swirl.
- Once entire swirl is beaded, come back up at one end of the swirl, and go back through the entire swirl, going back down at the opposite end.
- Gently "tug" the beading thread, and the curves of the swirl will smooth out.

Graphs are for representation of the rhythm of a stitch, and may not fit the specific, painted area. Unless otherwise instructed, the stitches should be compensated to fit the painted area, appropriately.
