
Technique: Basketweave

Beading

Recommended beading threads: clear Sulky sewing thread; 4lb Test Fireline


 Beads are applied with crossstitches, moving in diagonal rows, like basketweave.

- The first stitch of the crossstitch, no matter which directional thread you are covering, goes from the lower left, through the bead, then back down in the upper right.
- When covering a vertical thread, the second stitch will come up in the lower right, come back through the bead from the bottom (lower left end) and then go back down in the upper left.
- When covering a horizontal thread, the second stitch will come up in the upper left, come back through the bead from the bottom (lower left end) and then go back down in the lower right.
- Move between stitches in diagonal rows, just like basketweave.



Area: Dark Orange Border Fiber: Magnifica #10098 Technique: Apply beads with a cross-stitch so the hole of the bead lies horizontally. As you work down the line, the beads will get crowded, so you will need to skip the occasional canvas thread intersection. The beads will crowd back up, so the gap will be absorbed.

Technique: Line Beading

- Apply each bead with a crossstitch so the hole of the bead lines up with the direction of the painted line.
- Once all the beads in the line are applied, bring the needle back up at the beginning.
- Pass the needle through each bead, going down to the back

at the opposite end.




- Using a large needle, open up the canvas hole at the top of the painted line.
- Plunge the Memory Thread to the back and anchor.
- Lay, and smooth the Memory Thread along the painted line.
- Repeat the process of opening the canvas hole at the bottom, plunging to the back and anchoring.
- Following the dots that are painted, couch the Memory Thread with the #8 braid with a cross stitch.




Area: White Border **Fiber:** Magnifica #10009 **Technique:** Line Beading

- Apply beads with a crossstitch so the hole of the bead sits vertically.
- Once the entire line is beaded, run the needle back through all the beads to keep them from wobbling.




Sequins

- Starting at the edge closest to the white border, lay a sequin on the canvas to the center hole lines up with the first canvas hole.
- Apply a stitch by coming up in the upper right corner, and going down in the center of the sequin.
- Apply another stitch, coming up in the lower right corner, going back through the center.
- Layer the next sequin on top of the first, and repeat until the line is covered.



Cover the entire area with the blue Splendor, then come back and place a stitch of the metallic ribbon every third stitch.

At the time this stitch guide was written, all threads and embellishments were available. In the event a thread or embellishment is discontinued, any similar material may be substituted with no negative effect on the finished product.

All graphs included in this guide are to illustrate the direction and/or rhythm of a stitch. They may not necessarily represent the painted area of a design, and compensation will be necessary in most areas.
