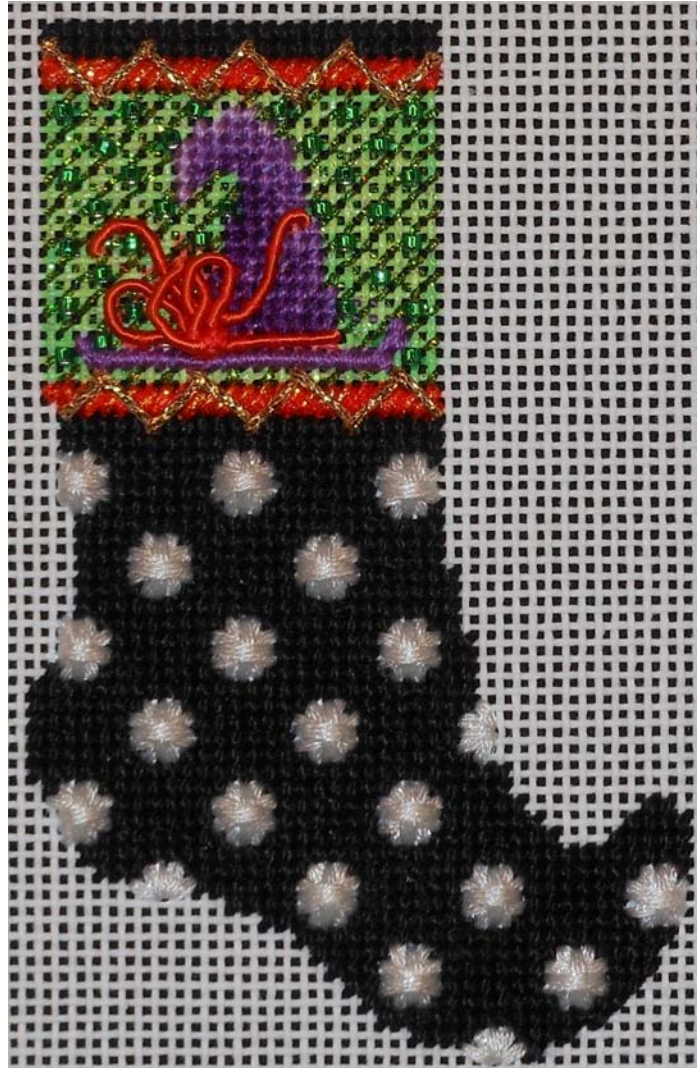

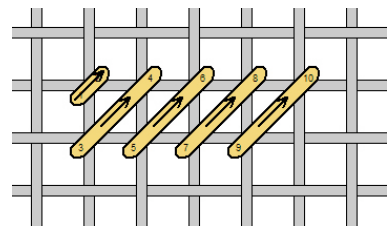

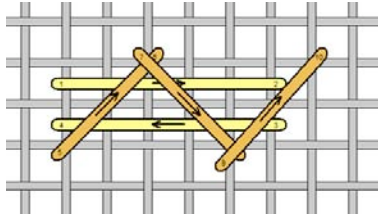


**Area:** Gold Top Stitching

**Stitch:** Overlapping Diagonal

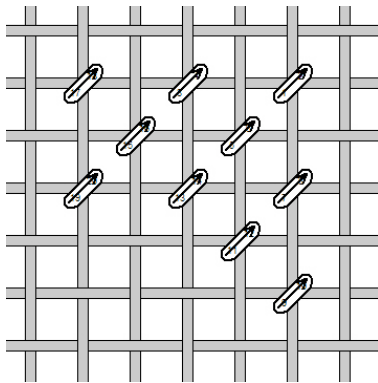


**Area:** Green Background

**Fibers:** #8 Braid #015L,  
Magnifica #10067

**Stitch:** Skip Tent with Bead

- Execute skip tent, working on horizontal threads. Disregard the painted bow, stitching right over it.
- Once all stitching is done, apply a bead to every other vertical thread.



**Area:** Hat

**Fiber:** 4 ply Needlepoint Inc.  
Silk #454, #454, #105

**Stitch:** Tent (Basketweave)

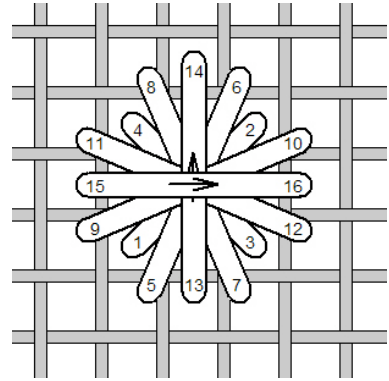
**Area:** Bow

**Fibers:** Memory Thread #6150,  
1 ply Embroidery Floss #946

**Technique:** Couched memory Thread

1. Begin by opening up the hole at the beginning of the design, using a larger needle.

2. After cutting a length about 1" longer than you think you will need, plunge one end into the opened hole, and anchor on the back.
3. Shaping into place as you go, couch down occasionally, using 1 ply of embroidery floss.
4. For the bow loops, you will want to couch loops into place, plunging to the back after a couple of the loops, coming back up in adjacent holes.
5. At the end, open up the last hole, plunge to the back and anchor.

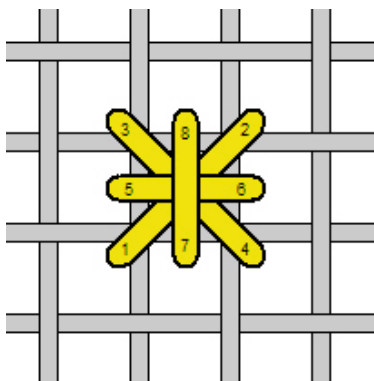


**Area:** Dots

**Fibers:** 1/16th" Ribbon #100  
Petite Very Velvet #V602

**Stitch:** Padded Rhodes

- First execute a Smyrna Cross in the center of each dot using the petite very velvet.
- Next, stitch a Rhodes on top of the Smyrna, using 1/16th" ribbon.
