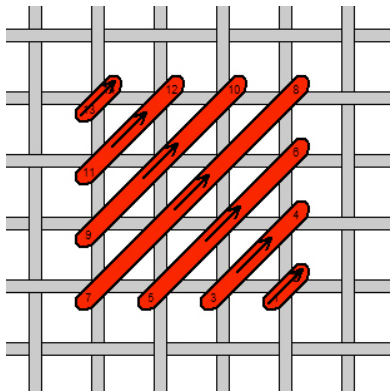

**Technique:** Line Beading

- All beads will be applied with a cross stitch.
- When covering vertical lines in the design, start at the top. Come up in the lower left hand corner, go through the bead, then back down into the upper right hand hole.
- Next, come up in the lower right hand hole, go back through the bottom of the bead (the end that is angled towards the lower left hand hole) and go back down in the upper left hand hole.
- Once the entire section is done, come back up in the lower left hand hole, run your needle through all of the beads in the section, and go back down in the upper right hand hole of the top stitch.
- Then come back up in the upper left hand hole of the top stitch, go back through the section, and go back down into the lower right hand hole of the last stitch.
- (Depending on the weight of your beading thread, the step of running an elongated cross-stitch may not fit. Sulky clear sewing thread was used for the model.)
- For the beads covering the horizontal stripes of the design, start on the right.
- Come up in the lower left hand hole, go through the bead, and back down into the upper right hand hole.
- Next, come back up in the upper left hand hole, go back through the bottom of

the bead, and then back down into the lower right hand hole.

- Follow the same steps as for the vertical lines.

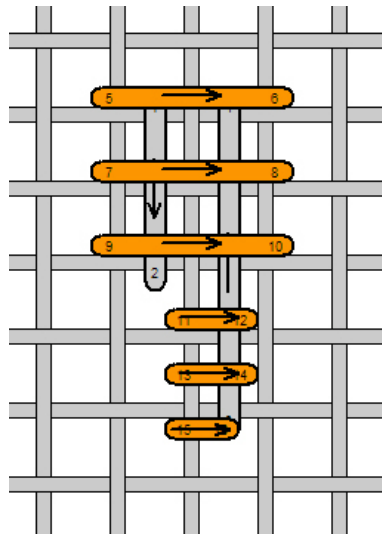

**Technique:** Twisted and Couched

- Using your needle, open up the two holes on either side of the first stitch.
- Coming from the back, plunge the ends of a length of Memory Thread, pulling until it is tight to the back.
- Tightly twist the two lengths together, checking occasionally to see if you

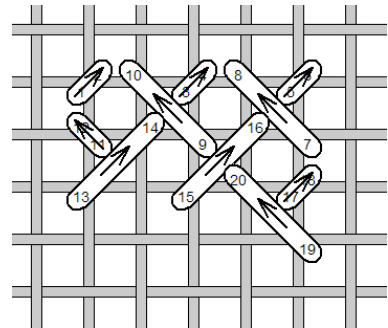
have enough to cover the painted line.

- Once you have enough twisted, open up the holes on either side of the last stitch, and plunge to the back.
- Using either a similarly colored floss, or clear beading thread, couch the twist occasionally, and anchor the ends to the back.
