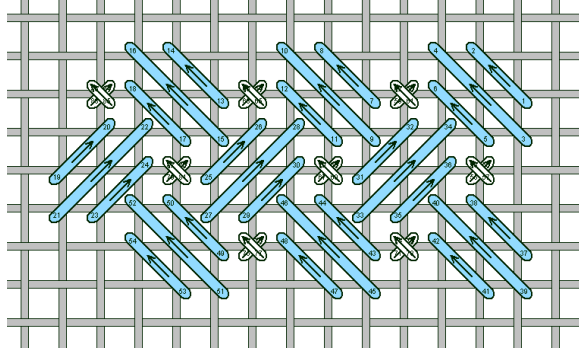

**Area:** "S"

**Fibers:** Neon Rays #N68, #12 Braid #032

**Stitch:** Criss-Cross Hungarian

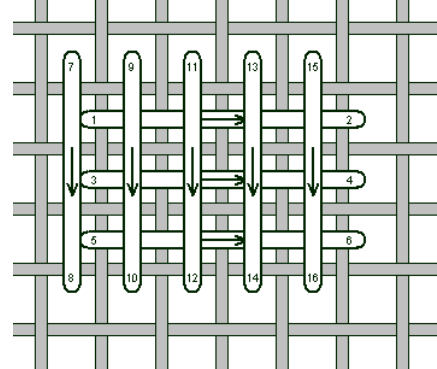


Tip: You can iron, dampen, or rub the Neon Rays on a warm light bulb to remove the kinks and make laying this fiber easier.

**Area:** "O" Snowmen Bodies

**Fiber:** Razzle Dazzle 6 #D307, Very Velvet #V202

**Stitch:** Padded Vertical Satin

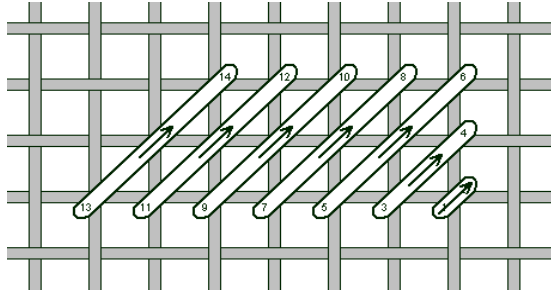


Lay in horizontal stitches with Very Velvet, and then lay in vertical stitches of Razzle Dazzle. Razzle Dazzle frays very easily, so use relatively short lengths.

**Area:** "N", White Stripes

**Fiber:** Petite Frosty Rays #PY217

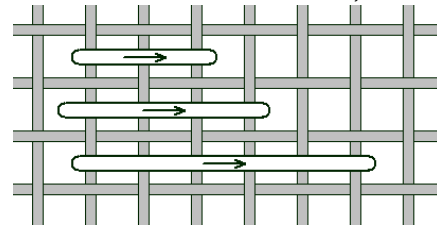
**Stitch:** Goebelin



**Area:** "O" Snowmen Hats

**Fiber:** Very Velvet #V201

**Stitch:** Horizontal Satin, Tent Stitch

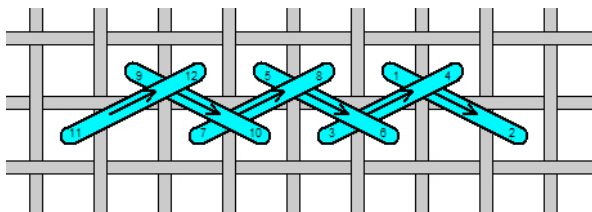


Tent stitch the hat brim.

**Area:** "N", Blue and Green Stripes

**Fibers:** 1/16 Ribbon #015L, 033L

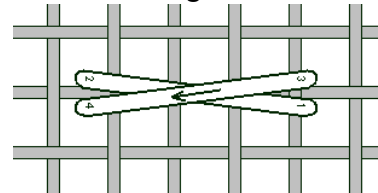
**Stitch:** Overlapping Line Stitch



**Area:** "O" Snowmen Hat Bands

**Fiber:** 1/16 Ribbon #033L

**Stitch:** Elongated Cross-Stitch



**Area:** "O" Background

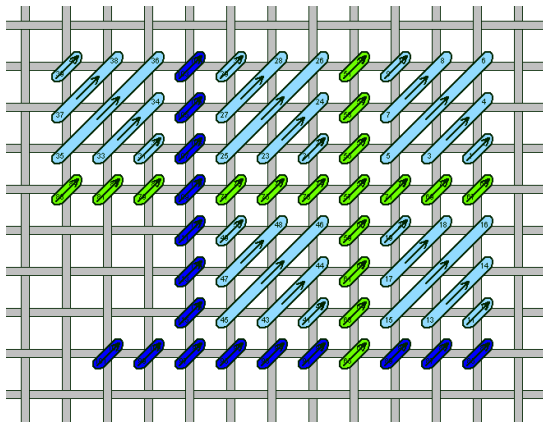
**Fiber:** 8 ply Splendor #S972

**Stitch:** Tent Stitch

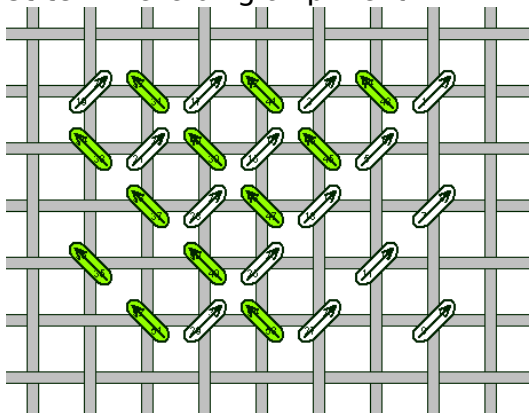
**Area:** "O" Snowmen Noses  
**Fiber:** Petite Frosty Rays #PY368  
**Stitch:** Faux Bullion



**Area:** "W"  
**Fibers:** #16 Braid # 032, 1/16<sup>th</sup> Ribbon #015L, Fyre Werks #FT17, Water N' Ice #WT2  
**Stitch:** Framed Scotch Stitch



**Area:** Background  
**Fiber:** Vineyard Silk #C088  
**Stitch:** Reversing Skip-Tent



Work the entire background in skip tent, then turn the canvas 45 degrees and work at the opposite angle. Stitch over the "arms" of the large snowflakes.

**Area:** "let it"  
**Fiber:** Memory Thread #6070  
**Technique:** Twisted and Couched

1. At the first stitch, use a large needle to "stretch" the holes on either side.
2. Coming from the back, come to the front with the Memory Thread, through both holes.
3. Twist the 2 lengths of Memory Thread, creating a length longer than you think you will need for the entire word.
4. Lay the twisted threads along the painted line, couching as you go along. It is easier to "hide" the couching thread if you go into the center of the twist.
5. When you get to the end, again stretch out the holes on either side of the last stitch.
6. Take each end of the Memory Thread down through the canvas, bending back against the canvas.
7. Using your couching thread, secure the folded ends to the back.
8. Trim the Memory Thread fairly close to the secured area.

**Area:** 1 Stitch "Snowflakes"  
**Beads:** Size 11 Hex #H250  
**Fiber:** Sparkle Braid #SK06  
**Technique:** Apply Beads with a Cross-Stitch

**Area:** 2 over 2 "Snowflakes"  
**Beads:** 4mm Bicones  
**Fiber:** Sparkle Braid #SK06  
**Technique:** Apply beads with either cross stitch, or go through twice.

Normally, a cross-stitch is recommended for applying beads, but angling the bicone beads gave them more interest. Either technique would work.
