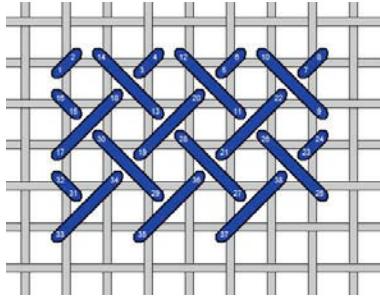

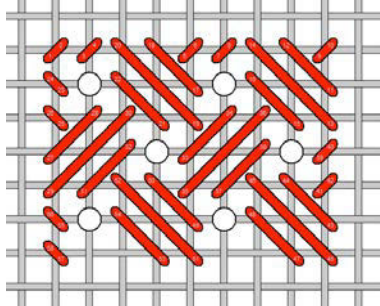

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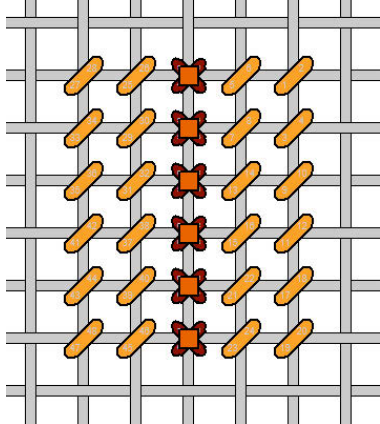
Area: Background
Thread: Opal #074S
Stitch: Woven

Threads: Neon Rays #N20,
 10/0 Delica #0202
Stitch: Criss-Cross Hungarian
 with Beads



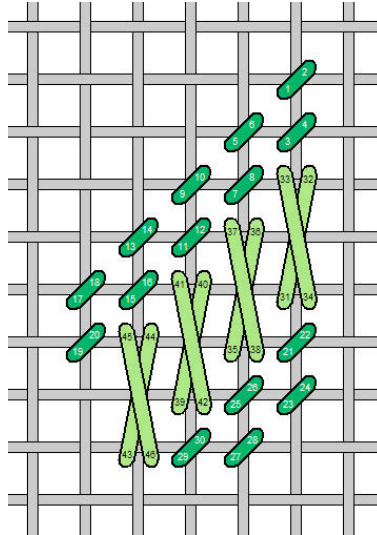
Area: "E"
Threads: Planet Earth Silk #011,
 10/0 Delica #0151, Sparkle
 Braid #SK16
Stitch: Tent with Line Beading



After tent stitching stripes, apply beads with a cross-stitch, using

Sparkle Braid so the holes line up vertically. Once an entire stripe is complete, go back through the entire line with a single, stabilizing stitch.

Area: "J"
Threads: 6 ply Splendor #S828,
 #12 Braid #3215
Stitch: Encroaching Cross-Stitch
 over 3 with Tent Stitch



Area: "O"
Threads: 10/0 Delica
 #DB-0079, 11/0 Delica
 #DB0079, Sparkle Braid #SK06
Technique: Basketweave
 Beading

Because the area you are beading is large, use the 10/0 Delicas for most of the beading, but use the 11/0 Delicas for every 6th row. This will ease the "pressure" and allow you to bead every row.

- The first step, regardless of whether you are covering a horizontal or a vertical canvas thread is to come up in the lower left hand hole, go through the bead, then back

down in the upper right hand hole. This is a classic tent stitch. The bead will slant from the lower left to the upper right, just like the stitch.

- When covering a horizontal thread, come back up in the upper left hand hole, go through the bottom of the bead (the end nearest the lower left hand hole), and then go back down in the lower right hand hole. This will "pull" the bead into a horizontal position.
- Moving just like basketweave, continue to apply any beads covering horizontal threads in that diagonal row.
- When covering a vertical thread, follow the first step. For the second step, come up in the lower right hand hole, go through the bottom of the bead (again, the end nearest the lower left hand hole,) and then go back down in the upper left hand hole. This will "pull" the bead into a vertical position.
- Moving just like basketweave, continue to apply beads covering vertical threads in that diagonal row.

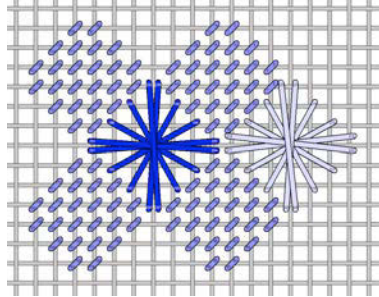
Once an area is completed, you might need to "scoot" the beads on the outer edges towards the center for tightly packed coverage.

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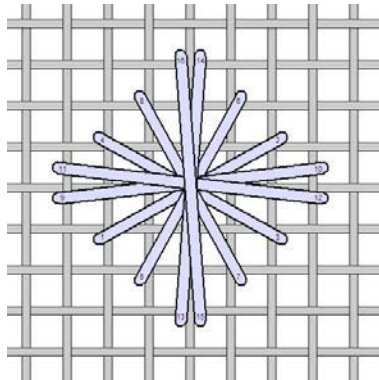

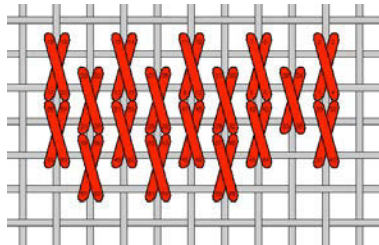
Illustrating the whole pattern:



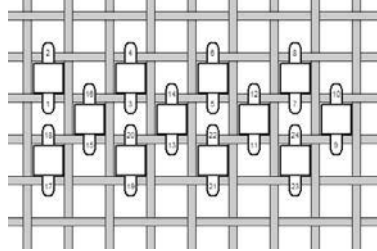
Rhodes Diamond:



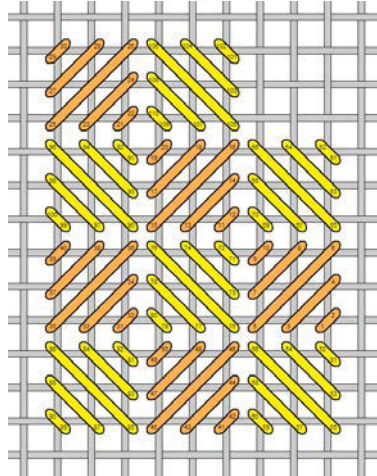
Area: Red and White "L," Red

 Cross-Stitch



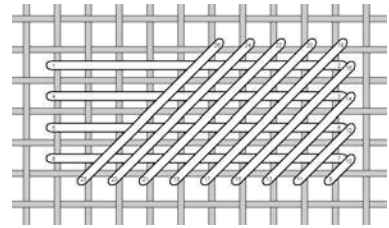
Area: Red and White "L,"

Technique: Brick Beading



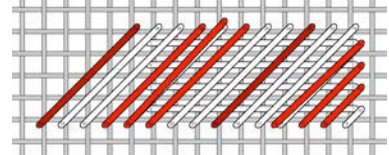
Area: "Y"

Stitch: Reversing Scotch Stitch



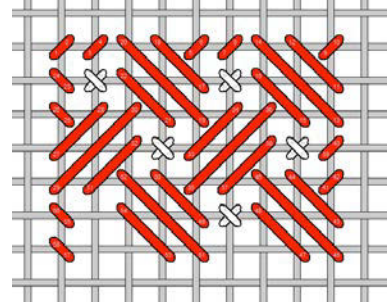
Area: Candy Cane Border

 #V202
Stitch: Padded Diagonal Satin
*Step 1: Lay long horizontal
 stitches of Very Velvet, then
 cover the entire border in
 Diagonal Satin, using Petite
 Frosty Rays.*



*Step 2: Referring to the photos,
 or a color copy, place the wide
 red stripes using 1/16th" ribbon,
 and the narrow using #12 braid.*



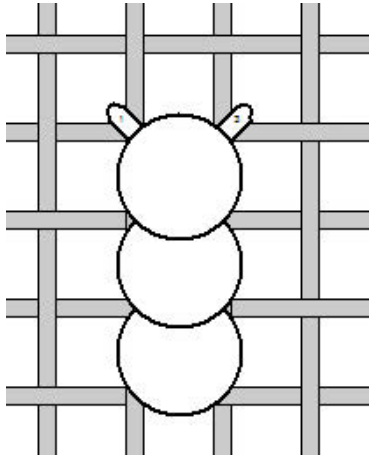
Area: Red Dotted Stripe

Stitch: Criss-Cross Hungarian



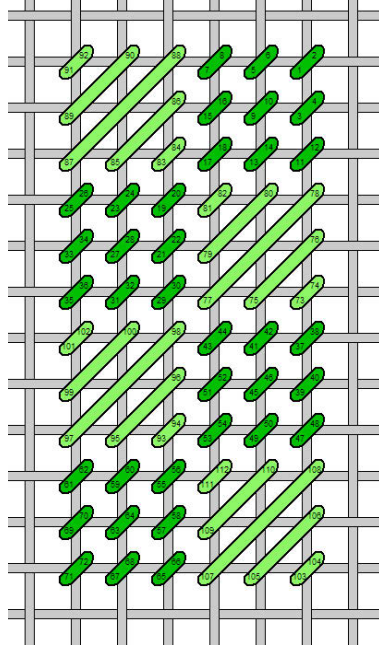
Area: Narrow White Stripe
Threads: DM4-41(sequins),
 Sparkle Braid #SK06
Technique: Layered Sequins

- Starting at the bottom, apply a sequin by applying a tent stitch in the upper right corner, then a reversed tent stitch in the upper left corner.
- Go up one row, and apply the next sequin, layering over the previous.

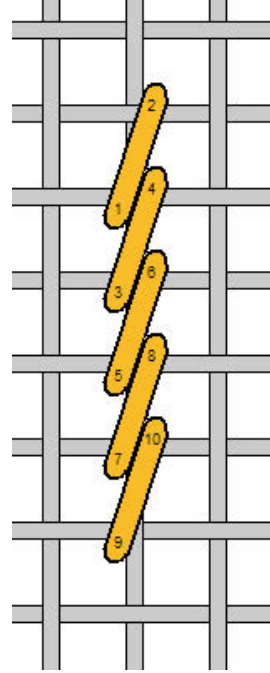
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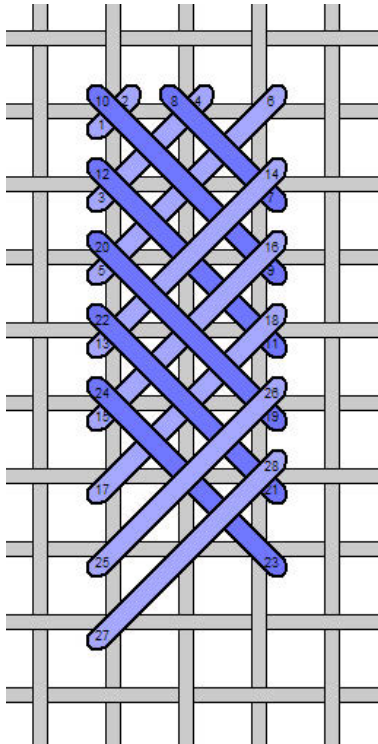
Area: Green Checkered Stripe

Stitch: Braided Satin Stitch

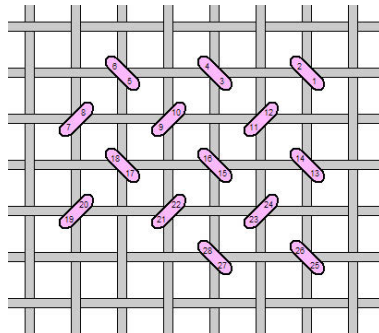

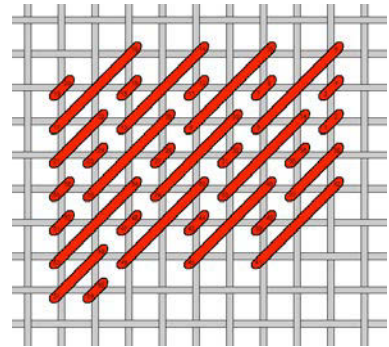
Area: Narrow Aqua Stripe
Thread: 11/0 Delica #DB-0079
Technique: Apply beads with a cross-stitch so the hole of the bead lines up horizontally.

Area: Medium Red Stripe
Thread: 6 ply Splendor #S911
Stitch: Tent

Area: Pink Stripe
Thread: #16 Braid #055F
Stitch: T-Stitch



Area: Wide Red Stripe
Thread: 1/16th" Ribbon #5505
Stitch: Nobuko



Area: Navy Blue Stripe
Thread: #12 Braid #018HL
Stitch: Woven

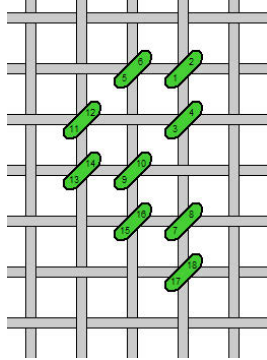
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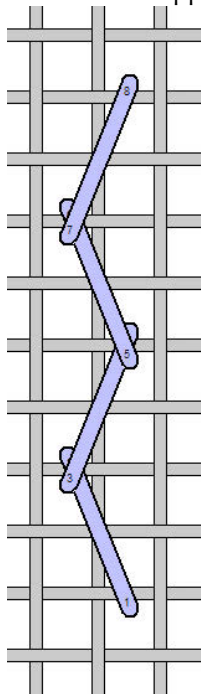
Area: Medium Green Stripe
Threads: 6 ply Splendor #S828, Sundance 6MM Bugle Beads #BDS-BB-15, Sparkle Braid #SK25

Technique: Tent Stitch with Bugle Beads

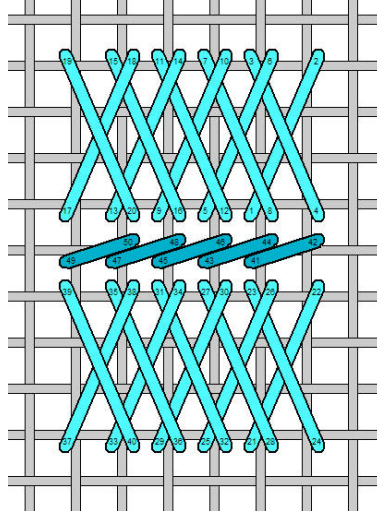
- Tent stitch the stripe in Splendor, skipping diagonal rows as illustrated.
- After tent stitching is complete, apply bugle beads with Sparkle Braid.



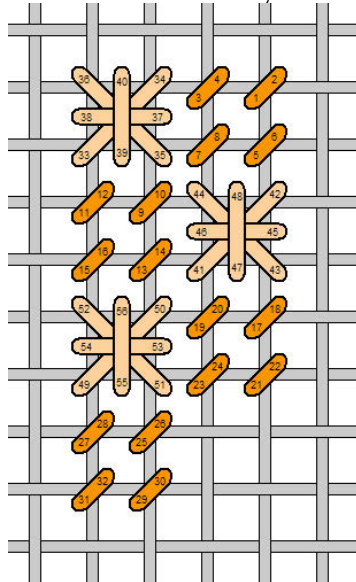
Area: Narrow Lavender Stripe
Thread: #12 Braid #3215
Stitch: Overlapping Line Stitch



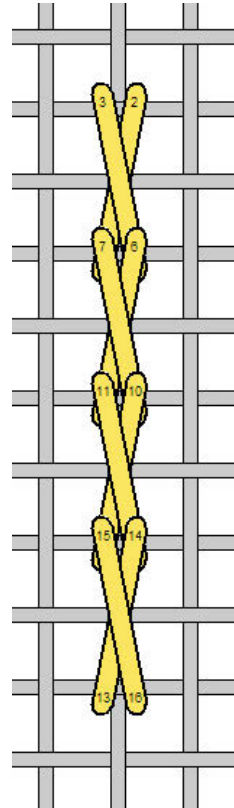
Area: Aqua and Dark Aqua Stripe
Threads: 6 ply Splendor #S952, 1/16th" Ribbon #029L
Stitches: Overlapping Elongated Cross-Stitch with Elongated Tent



Area: Orange Checkered Stripe
Threads: Planet Earth Silk #011, #12 Braid #5765
Stitches: Tent and Smyrna Cross



Area: Narrow Yellow Stripe
Thread: #8 Braid #091 Star Yellow
Stitch: Overlapping Elongated Cross-Stitch
